

Excerpted from the Hunter Dry Suit Manual

HUNTER LIMITED GUARANTEE

Hunter Diving Suits are warranted to the original purchaser only and from the date of purchase as follows: The suit material and zipper will not leak for one (1) year; the seals will not leak for three (3) months; and the vulcanized seams will not leak for the life of suit. End of life occurs when any component of the suit, other than the vulcanised seams ceases to perform satisfactorily beyond the guarantee period.

This is a limited guarantee (warranty). There is no other guarantee express or implied. This guarantee is voided if a Hunter Diving Suit is:

- a) used under any condition not recommended in this manual
- b) not cared for as set forth in this manual
- c) otherwise misused, abused, neglected or damaged

Drysuits which are used for rental, teaching purposes or commercial operations are excluded from this warranty.

The warranty does not cover damage to suit components or materials where the suit has been exposed to chemicals and subsequently nor cleaned immediately and thoroughly.

A claim under this guarantee must be made to Hunter within thirty (30) days of the discovery of a leak during the guarantee period. After receipt of the Diving Suit and a copy of the sales receipt from the purchaser, shipping prepaid, Hunter will inspect the suit. If in Hunter's sole judgement the claim is accepted, the suit will be repaired, replaced, or the purchase price refunded to the purchaser, at Hunter's option. This is the exclusive remedy. Liability for consequential or incidental damages is excluded to the extent that exclusion is permitted by law.

(United States purchasers only) SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THE ABOVE EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS WHICH MAY VARY FROM STATE TO STATE.

All Hunter manufactured Drysuits have received CE type approval under EC Council Directive 89/686/EEC, and are deemed to meet basic Health and Safety requirements (Annex II) of the Directive.
